ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have allocated an amount of Rs.3300 lakh as the Central Share for the Implementation of Rainfed Area Development component of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture for 2019-20 and the Government have sent the Annual Action Plan for an outlay of Rs.8419.026 lakh under Rain fed Area Development for the year 2019-20 to Government of India for approval.

- 2. The Government of India have restricted the Annual Action Plan to the allocation and have approved it for an outlay of Rs.5500 lakh under Rain fed Area Development for the year 2019-20 and released a sum of Rs.1980 lakh which is 60% of Government of India share of Rs.3300 lakh under Rain fed Area Development National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture. The corresponding State Share for the first installment release is Rs.1320.00 lakh.
- 3. The Government of India has approved the Action Plan for 46 clusters covering an area of 4600 ha subject to certain condition that the programme is implemented in cluster mode focusing on the true spirit of the mission with Integrated Farming System as the core approach of development.

4. Based on the above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has sent the proposals according to the release made by the Government of India and requested to sanction Rs.3300.00 lakh (Government of India Share Rs.1980.00 lakh + State Share Rs.1320 lakh) as first installment under Rainfed Area Development Component as per the proposals given by the implementing Departments during 2019-20 as given below:-

- 5. He has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders under Rainfed Area Development Component as per the proposals given by implementing departments viz. Agriculture, Horticulture, Agricultural Marketing and Agri-Business and Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for an amount of Rs.3300 lakh (Government of India share Rs.1980 lakh+ State share Rs.1320 lakh) and to issue order on the issues as requested by the implementing departments.
- 6. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.5500.00 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3300.00 lakh (Rupees thirty three crore only) (Government of India share Rs.1980.00 lakh + State share Rs.1320.00 lakh) as 1st instalment for implementation of Rain fed Area Development component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture to the implementing departments during 2019-20 as detailed below:-

- 7. The implementing departments, shall adhere to the physical and financial targets and head of account wise fund allocation are indicated in Annexures I, II and III appended to this order.
- 8. Necessary additional funds of Rs.11,55,50,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-20 under the relevant heads of account as detailed below:-

- 9. Pending provision of such funds the Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above to the concerned. However, the expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2019-2020. The Director of Agriculture is directed to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposal for Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2019-20 and also to send necessary draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2019-20 to the Government in Finance (BG-1/Agri) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
- 10. The Director of Horticulture is also authorised to draw Rs.1155.01 lakh and disburse the same to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency for implementing the projects, and relaxation on quarterly restriction of fund may be given for effective implementation of the scheme in time.
- 11. The Director of Horticulture & Plantation Crops is permitted to fix the Physical target based on the need and potential of the districts.

- 12. The Director of Agriculture is authorised to draw the administrative cost sanctioned in para 6 above and disburse the same to the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is permitted to release a sum of Rs.55.00 lakh to the Director of Agriculture and a sum of Rs.21.22 lakh to the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, available under 5% administrative fund of Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for Administrative Expenses like Junior Research Fellows Salary and Other Contingencies.
- 13. The Director of Agriculture is also authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned for the Farmer Producer Organisation formation amount to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Small Farmers' Agri business Consortium for the implementation of the same.
- 14. The implementing departments shall follow the National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture Rainfed Area Development Guidelines scrupulously issued by the Government of India and follow the cost norms and pattern of assistance while implementing the projects and to ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them in time.
- 15. The Implementing Departments are directed to monitor the implementation process and progress at the State and District levels effectively and to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency and to the Government.
- 16. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is directed to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to the Government without fail.
- 17. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.50896/Agri/2019, dated 24.10.2019 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1875 (One thousand eight hundred and seventy five).
