#### ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have allocated an amount of Rs.3300 lakh as the Central share for the implementation of Rainfed Area Development component of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture for the year 2019-2020. The corresponding State share works out to Rs.2200 lakh.

2. In the letter second read above, Annual Action Plan (AAP) of Rainfed Area Development Component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) was approved for an amount of Rs.5500 lakh (Government of India share Rs.3300 lakh + State share

Rs.2200 lakh) with a sharing pattern of 60:40 between Centre and State for the year 2019-2020.

- 3. In the Government Order third read above, administrative approval was accorded for a sum of Rs.5500.00 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3300.00 lakh (Government of India share of Rs.1980.00 lakh + State share of Rs.1320.00) as first instalment for implementation of Rainfed Area Development component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture during the year 2019-2020.
- 4. In the letter fourth read above, the Government of India have released an amount of Rs.1320 lakh (under General, Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (SCSP) & Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) categories) as the second instalment and the corresponding 40% of the State share works out to Rs.880 lakh.
- 5. Based on the above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has sent proposal according to the release made by the Government of India and requested to sanction Rs.2200.00 lakh (Government of India share of Rs.1320.00 lakh + State share of Rs.880.00) as second instalment under Rainfed Area Development component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture as per proposals given by the implementing Departments as given below:-

The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has stated that for the Department of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business, Rs.15.00 lakh is required in addition to the amount sanctioned as first and second instalment for formation of 5 Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) at a cost of Rs.125.00 Lakh @

Rs.25.00 Lakh per Farmer Producer Organization. He has also stated that a reserve fund of Rs.28.097 lakh is already available with Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency from 2% of 5% administrative cost sanctioned in the previous years from 2016-2017 to 2018-2019 for Farmer Producer Organization formation as funds required only to the level of Farmer Producer Organizations formed were utilized. He has requested to permit him to release a sum of Rs.15.00 lakh from administrative funds (2%) meant for Farmer Producer Organization formation of Rainfed Area Development to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Small Farmers' Agri Business Consortium for the Farmer Producer Organization formation.

- 7. He has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders under Rainfed Area Development component of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture as per the proposals given by implementing departments viz., Agriculture, Horticulture, Agricultural Marketing and Agri-Business and Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for an amount of Rs.2200.00 lakh (Government of India share of Rs.1320.00 lakh + State share of Rs.880.00) and to issue orders as requested by the implementing departments.
- 8. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2200.00 lakh (Rupees twenty two crore only) (Government of India share of Rs.1320.00 lakh + State share of Rs.880.00) as second instalment for implementation of Rainfed Area Development component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture to the implementing departments during 2019-2020 as detailed below:-

- 9. The implementing departments shall adhere to the physical and financial targets and head of account wise fund allocation are indicated in Annexure I, II and III appended to this order.
- 10. Necessary funds will be provided in Final Modified Appropriation, 2019-2020 the Director of Agriculture and the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops are authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 8 above to the concerned.
- 11. The Director of Agriculture is also authorized to draw the 3% administrative cost sanctioned in para 8 above and disburse the same to the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency.
- 12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (FAC) is permitted to release a sum of Rs.36.68 lakh from 3% administrative funds of Rainfed Area-Development to the Director of Agriculture towards contingencies and salary of Junior Research Fellows.
- 13. The Director of Agriculture is also authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned for the Farmer Producer Organisation formation amount to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Small Farmers' Agri business Consortium for the implementation of the same.
- 14. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is permitted to release a sum of Rs.15.00 lakh from administrative funds (2%) meant for Farmer Producer Organizations formation of Rainfed Area Development to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Small Farmers' Agri Business Consortium for the Farmer Producer Organization formation.
- 15. The district Joint Directors of Agriculture are authorized to draw the funds allocated under the Animal Husbandry components viz., Dairy Based Farming System, Livestock Based Farming System (Small Ruminants) and transfer the funds to the bank account of Joint Directors of Animal Husbandry concerned.
- 16. The district Joint Directors of Agriculture are authorized to draw the fund allocated under the Horticulture components viz., Horticulture Based Farming system, Apiculture and transfer the funds to the bank account of Deputy Directors of Horticulture concerned.
- 17. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw Rs.770.01 lakh and disburse the same to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticultural Development Agency for implementing the projects.
- 18. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (FAC) is permitted to release a sum of Rs.14.14 lakh from 3% administrative funds of Rainfed Area Development to the Director of Horticulture towards contingencies and salary of Junior Research Fellows.
- 19. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to fix the Physical target based on the need and potential of the districts.



- 20. The implementing Departments are directed to scrupulously follow the instructions issued in the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above.
- 21. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.14014/Agri/2020, dated 20.3.2020.
