ORDER:

The Government of India have allocated an amount of Rs.3000 lakh as the Central share for the implementation of Rainfed Area Development (RAD) component of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) for the year 2020-2021. In the letter second read above, the Annual Action Plan for Rainfed Area Development under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture at the cost of Rs.50.00 crore has been sent to Government of India for approval. The corresponding State share works out to Rs.2000 lakh.

2. In the letter third read above, the Government of India have approved the Annual Action Plan (AAP) of Rainfed Area Development Component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) for an amount of Rs.5000 lakh (Government of India share Rs.3000 lakh +

State share Rs.2000 lakh) with a sharing pattern of 60:40 between Centre and State for the year 2020-2021.

- 3. In the letter fourth read above, the Government of India have released an amount of Rs.1500.00 lakh which is 50% of Government of India share of Rs.3000.00 lakh under Rainfed Area Development component of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture 2020-2021 as the first instalment and the corresponding 40% of the State share works out to Rs.1000 lakh.
- 4. Based on the above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has sent proposal according to the release made by the Government of India and requested to sanction Rs.2500.00 lakh (Government of India share of Rs.1500.00 lakh + State share of Rs.1000.00 lakh) as first instalment under Rainfed Area Development component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture as per proposals given by the implementing Department, as given below:-

The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has stated that as per the Rainfed Area Development guidelines, the Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency in the capacity of Nodal Agency for National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture is eligible for an amount of Rs.249.98 lakh as 5% admin fund under Rainfed Area Development based on the original allocation of Rs.5000.00 lakh by Government of India. Further, as per the Rainfed Area Development Guidelines, the cost of

formation of Farmer Producer Organisation restricted to 2% of the 5% Admin cost admissible under Rainfed Area Development for the Nodal Agency should be met from Admin fund. Accordingly, an amount of Rs.100.00 lakh has been earmarked for Farmer Producer Organisation formation. The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing & Agri Business has proposed an amount of Rs.50.00 lakh for two Farmer Producer Organisations at Rs.25.00 lakh/Farmer Producer Organisation based on the first instalment release.

- 5. He has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders under Rainfed Area Development component of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture as per the proposals given by implementing departments viz., Agriculture, Horticulture, Agricultural Marketing and Agri-Business and Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for an amount of Rs.2500.00 lakh (Government of India share of Rs.1500.00 lakh + State share of Rs.1000.00 lakh) and to issue orders on the issues as requested by the implementing departments.
- 6. The Government after careful examination, of the proposal of the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency hereby accord administrative approval for a sum of Rs.5000.00 lakh for implementation of Rainfed Area Development component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture during the year 2020-2021 and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2500.00 lakh (Rupees Twenty five crore only) (Government of India share of Rs.1500.00 lakh + State share of Rs.1000.00 lakh) as first instalment as detailed below:-

- 7. The above sanctioned amount includes a sum of Rs.124.99 lakh proportional to the release of Rs.2500.00 lakh as first instalment admissible under Rainfed Area Development component to Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency to meet the administrative expenditure and to release to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Small Farmers' Agri business Consortium/Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing & Agri Business for Farmer Producer Organisations formation with regard to implementation of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture in the State.
- 8. The Department wise detailed components and head of account wise fund allocation are indicated in Annexure I, II and III appended to this order.
- 9. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above to the concerned duly relaxing quarterly restriction of funds.
- 10. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw the amount of administrative fund sanctioned in para 6 above and disburse it to the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for depositing into the savings Bank account for incurring administrative expenditure at Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency and to Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Small Farmers' Agri business Consortium / Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing & Agri Business for Farmer Producer Organisation formation.
- 11. The District Joint Directors of Agriculture are authorized to draw the funds allocated and transfer to the Joint Director (Animal Husbandry) components viz., Livestock based Farming (Small Ruminants) and Dairy Based Farming system.
- 12. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw Rs.875.01 lakh and to disburse the same to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency (TANHODA), for implementing the projects duly relaxing quarterly restriction of funds.
- 13. The District Joint Directors of Agriculture are authorized to draw the funds allotted and transfer to the Joint Director of Horticulture/Deputy Director of Horticulture in case of Apiary Units, and Fruits Plants.
- 14. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is permitted to fix the Physical target based on the need and potential of the districts.
- 15. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is permitted to release a sum of Rs.37.64 lakh to the Director of Agriculture and a sum of Rs.21.20 lakh to the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops from 5% administrative fund of Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for Administrative Expenses like Junior Research Fellows Salary and Other contingencies.

- 16. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned for the Farmer Producer Organisation formation amount to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Small Farmers' Agri business Consortium for the implementation of the same.
- 17. The implementing departments are instructed to scrupulously follow the National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture Guidelines issued by the Government of India and follow the cost norms and pattern of assistance while implementing the projects and to ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them in time.
- 18. The implementation departments are also instructed to monitor the implementation process and progress at the State and District levels effectively and to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency and to the Government.
- 19. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.25678/Finance (Agri)/2020, dated 18.08.2020.
