Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare Department - National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) – Implementation of Rainfed Area Development (RAD) component under NMSA in Tamil Nadu during the year 2021-2022 – Administrative approval for Rs.5000.00 lakh - Financial sanction of Rs.2278.75 lakh as first instalment towards the implementing Departments i.e. Department of Agriculture and Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops – Orders - Issued.

#### ORDER:

The Rainfed Area Development is one of the components under the Centrally Sponsored Umbrella Scheme, "National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture" being implemented since the year 2014-2015. The Rain fed Area Development is implemented with an aim to promote Integrated Farming System with emphasis on multi cropping, rotational cropping, inter-cropping practices with allied activities like horticulture, livestock, agro-forestry, apiculture. etc. to enable farmers to maximize the farm returns and also to mitigate the impacts of extreme weather events. Keeping this in view, an announcement has been made in exclusive Agriculture and Farmers

Welfare Department's Budget 2021-2022 that Integrated Farming System would be implemented under NMSA-RAD & NADP during 2021-2022 to increase the income and employment opportunities of Farm families at an outlay of Rs.59.85 crore with Union and State Government funds.

- 2. In this regard, in the letter first read above, the Government of India have allocated an amount of Rs.3000.00 lakh as the Central share for the implementation of Rainfed Area Development component of NMSA for the year 2021-22. In the letter second read above, the Government of India have approved the Annual Action Plan for an outlay of Rs.5000.00 lakh (Central Share Rs.3000 lakh + State Share Rs.2000.00 lakh) as on prevailing funding pattern of assistance( i.e. 60% Central Share and 40% State Share)for developing an Integrated Farming System area of 10250 ha. under RAD component of NMSA for the year 2021-22 and released a sum of Rs.1500 lakh as first installment which is 50% of Government of India share of Rs.3000 lakh for the above said project during the year 2021-22.
- 3. Accordingly, in the letter third read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has stated that the corresponding State share for the first installment release is Rs.1000 lakh and furnished a consolidated Head of Account proposals of Director of Agriculture, Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services and Director of Sericulture based on the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment release of GOI and briefed as below:

In respect of \*administrative fund(including FPO formation cost), the ED, TAWDEVA(in the capacity of Nodal Agency for NMSA, is eligible for acquiring 5% admn. fund of original allocation of fund by Central &State Govt.) has stated that the previous year's admin fund of RAD component of NMSA is available in TAWDEVA and to be utilized to meet out the admin expenditure of RAD implementing departments and TAWDEVA. It has been further stated that at present, the admin fund for this year (2021-22) is not proposed to be claimed and is kept in reserve for scheme components based on need for which the additional proposal would be received from the implementing department and forwarded to Government of India for approval.

4. The new procedure for release and utilization of funds of Central Sector Schemes (CSS) [1. through PFMS and through Single Nodal Account of Designated Single Nodal Agencies 2. the funds are available only in the State Nodal Account and is not physically transferred to the district offices down below and 3. opening of Zero Subsidiary accounts down the ladder agencies], has been communicated by the Gol w.e.f. 01.07.2021. As a Nodal Agency for NMSA, all necessary steps have been taken up by the ED, TAWDEVA to operationalize the PFMS at the State level. The PFMS

implementation process with regard to RAD scheme has also been furnished by the Executive Director, TAWDEVA.

5. The Executive Director, TAWDEVA has also furnished the following specific requests of the implementing Departments as follows:

#### Requests of Director of Agriculture (with draft guidelines):

- ➤ To authorize the DOA to draw and disburse the amount for Rs.1252.16 lakh to the concerned single Nodal account relaxing quarterly restriction of funds for timely and effective implementation of scheme and;
- ➤ to permit him to implement the scheme through single nodal bank account linked with PFMS as the NMSA-RAD is being a centrally sponsored scheme and in order to implement the new procedure of fund release issued by Government of India as per PFMS.

#### Requests of Director of Horticulture(with draft guidelines):

- To provide necessary funds in General, SC and ST Heads to implement the programme.
- To authorize the Director of Horticulture and Plantation crops to draw Rs.1026.60 lakh for implementing the projects by relaxing quarterly restriction of fund for effective implementation of the scheme on time.
- To permit the Director of Horticulture and Plantation crops to draw and transfer the funds to the Single Nodal Account for implementing the projects as per the new procedure of fund flow through PFMS issued by Government of India.
- To permit the Director of Horticulture & Plantation Crops to fix the Physical target based on the need and potential of the districts.

### Requests of TAWDEVA:

- To permit the Executive Director, TAWDEVA to release a sum of Rs.41.60 lakh to the Director of Agriculture and a sum of Rs. 30.80 lakh to the Director of Horticulture and plantation Crops, and an amount of Rs. 0.063 lakh to Director of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services from 5% administrative fund, released under RAD in the previous years, available with the Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for Administrative Expenses like JRF Salary and Other Contingencies.
- The major Heads of Accounts of Department of Agriculture and Department of Horticulture and Scheme code (SLS code) of theirs have been linked/mapped by the State Finance Department. As Separate account Heads are not there for Department of Animal Husbandry, Department of Sericulture, and TAWDEVA, they could not be mapped in PFMS.
- To provide separate account Heads for the scheme in General, SC and ST categories under the drawing officer of Director of Agriculture for Department of Animal Husbandry, Department of Sericulture, and TAWDEVA since it is mandatory to map the separate Account Head with PFMS to register a new Single Nodal Agency in PFMS. To re-appropriate the available fund provision under RAD Heads of Accounts of Director of Agriculture to the newly created Heads of Account.

- To mention the department wise physical and financial targets and heads of account wise fund allocation for each department as per the component wise details furnished by him.
- To order the Implementing Departments to scrupulously follow the NMSA- RAD Guidelines issued by the Government of India and follow the cost norms and pattern of assistance while implementing the projects.
- To order the implementing departments to follow the fund releases only as per the PFMS procedure outlined by Government of India.
- To order the Implementing Departments to ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them in time.
- To order the Implementing Departments to monitor the implementation process and progress at the State & District levels effectively and to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency and to the Government.
- 6. Therefore, the ED. TAWDEVA has requested to issue Government orders under Rainfed Area Development Component as per the proposals given by implementing departments' viz. Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry and Sericulture for an amount of Rs.2375.48 lakh (Gol share Rs.1459.29 lakh+ State share Rs.950.192 lakh).
- 7. In this regard, while examining the proposal, the Government decided to call for separate proposals from the ED, TAWDEVA, in respect of Directorates of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services and Sericulture for opening new head of accounts, so as to sanction Rs.59.22 lakh and Rs.37.50 lakh respectively according fund provision under their demands for implementation of the above said scheme and for opening a new head of account in respect of provision of administrative funds as and when required. Accordingly, in the letter eighth read above, the ED, TAWDEVA has been requested to send separate proposals to Government.
- 8. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of ED, TAWDEVA, hereby accord an administrative sanction for Rs.5,000 lakh and financial sanction for Rs.2278.75 lakh(Rupees Twenty two crore seventy eight lakh and seventy five thousand only) [Gol share Rs.1367.25 lakh + State share Rs.911.50 lakh (excluding TAWDEVA's \*admn. fund Rs.124.52 lakh; Rs.59.22 lakh and Rs.37.50 lakh pertaining to Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services and Directorate of Sericulture respectively)] as first instalment, for the implementation of Rainfed Area Development Component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture to be implemented by the Departments of Agriculture and Horticulture and Plantation Crops as per the guidelines in annexure II to this order during the year 2021-22 as detailed below:-

- 9. The amount sanctioned in para 8 above shall be debited to the head of accounts provided in Annexure I to this order.
- 10. The implementing authorities are permitted to implement the scheme through single nodal bank account linked with PFMS in order to implement the new procedure of fund release issued by Government of India as per PFMS, as the NMSA-RAD is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme.
- 11. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw Rs.1252.15 lakh and disburse the amount to the concerned Single Nodal Account by relaxing quarterly restriction of funds for timely and effective implementation of scheme.
- 12. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw Rs.1026.60 lakh by relaxing quarterly restriction of fund for effective implementation of the scheme on time and she is also permitted to fix the physical target based on the need and potential of the districts.
- 13. The Executive Director, TAWDEVA is permitted to release a sum of Rs.41.60 lakh to the Director of Agriculture and a sum of Rs.30.80 lakh to the Director of Horticulture and plantation Crops, and an amount of Rs.0.063 lakh to Director of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services from 5% administrative fund, available with the Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for Administrative Expenses like JRF Salary and Other Contingencies.
  - 14. The Implementing authorities are hereby directed:
  - (i) to scrupulously follow the NMSA- RAD Guidelines issued by the Government of India and follow the cost norms and pattern of assistance while implementing the projects.
  - (ii) to follow the fund releases only as per the PFMS procedure outlined by Government of India.
  - (iii) to ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them in time.
  - (iv) to monitor the implementation process and progress at the State & District levels effectively and;

- (v) to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency as well as to the Government.
