ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, the Government accorded administrative sanction for Rs.6567.746 lakh and financial sanction for Rs.2673.74 lakh for implementation of horticultural activities of phase II (first year) for the year 2019-20, in 16 sub basins covering 17 districts under Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernization Project (TNIAMP).

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has stated that the scheme was implemented successfully during 2019-20 as a first year programme and also stated that MD?U directed to get the total financial sanction for the remaining project periods for Phase II implementation during the year 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 and requested for the financial sanction of Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernization Project (TNIAMP) activities implementation under phase II second year, third year and fourth year in 16 sub basins covering 17 districts for an amount of Rs.1610.664 lakh, Rs.1253.662 lakh and Rs.1029.680 lakh respectively from the already sanctioned (Administrative sanction) amount of Rs.6567.746 lakh. The year wise financial allocation are as follows:-

As a new initiative, crop incentive scheme is proposed to be introduced in the Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernization Project (TNIAMP) component of crop diversification in vegetables. In order to encourage impact area farmers an incentive amount of Rs.2500/ha will be given as a cultivation assistance. This will increase more impact area and thereby vegetable production also increased without exceeding overall budget.

- 3. In this connection, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has requested the Government to accord orders on the following issues:-
- (i) To accord financial sanction of Rs. 1610.664 lakh, Rs.1253.662 lakh and Rs.1029.680 lakh towards the implementation of phase II second year, third year and fourth year TNIAMP activities during 2020-21, 2021-2022 and 2022-23 respectively in 16 sub basins covering 17 districts according to the administrative sanction of Rs.6567.746 lakh for the entire phase II TNIAMP activities implementation vide G.O. (Ms) No. 231 Agriculture (WD2) Department, Dated:01.10.2019.
- (ii) To Permit the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops to interchange the component and also cost norms without altering/exceeding the total financial outlay. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops shall increase and decrease the target and funds based on the potential and need of the sub basins.
- (iii) To permit the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops to appoint Technical Input Providers-10 posts as per contract basis.

- 4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops hereby accord Financial sanction of Rs.1610.664 lakh (Rupees Sixteen Crore Ten lakhs Sixty six thousand and four hundred only) for the implementation of TNIAMP activities under Phase II second year during 2020-21.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para.4 above shall be debited to the following Heads of account:-
