Agriculture – Implemention of Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY) under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture – Sanction of Rs.336.60 lakh as second instalment for 200 new clusters approved during 2018-19 and Rs.266.966 lakh for the balance activities of previous years (2015-16 to 2018-19) and current year activities relating to the development of 112 old clusters - Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

- In Government Order first read above, sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.336.600 lakh as first instalment for implementation of Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY) under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) 2018-2019 with funding pattern of 60:40 between Central and State Governments.
- 2. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (TAWDEVA) in his letter fourth read above has stated that the GOI have conveyed the approval for allocation of funds to the tune of Rs. 504.90 lakh for the first year activities of 150 new clusters during 2018-19 as per the revised PKVY guidelines. Subsequently the Government of India had forwarded the minutes of the first Executive committee meeting held on 04.06.2018 under the Chairmanship of the Additional Secretary, INM (P.T.O.)

Division wherein it had been indicated that the allocation was Rs.673.20 lakh for the first year activities of 200 new clusters and Central share of Rs. 213.05 lakh as committed liabilities for the pending activities of 112 clusters which have already been approved during 2015-16 for the Implementation of PKVY under NMSA during 2018-19. He has further stated that out of Rs.403.92 lakh allocated, Rs.201.96 lakh was released as first instalment as the Central share (50% of Gol share of Rs.403.92 lakh). The corresponding state share for the first instalment release was Rs. 134.64 lakh. Accordingly orders have been issued for sanction of first instalment.

- 3. The ED, TAWDEVA has also stated that, Government of India have now released its balance share of Rs.201.96 lakh (General, SCP & ST) as the second instalment for the first year programme of 200 clusters approved during 2018-19 for which the corresponding 40% of the State share works out to Rs.134.64 lakh and have also released a sum of Rs. 160.17962 lakh as the Central share for the balance activities of previous years (2015-16 to 2018-19) and current year activities relating to the development of 112 (93+19) old clusters approved during 2015-16 and the 40 % State share works out to Rs.106.786 lakh.
- 4. Further the ED, TAWDEVA has also stated that as per the NMSA guidelines, the Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency, in the capacity of Nodal Agency for NMSA is eligible for an amount of Rs.6.60 lakh (Gol share Rs. 3.96 lakh + State share Rs. 2.64 lakh) as 2% admin fund for the first year programme of 200 clusters approved during 2018-19 and Rs. 2.641 lakh (Gol share Rs. 1.585 lakh + State share Rs. 1.056 lakh) as 1% Admin fund for the balance amount of third year activities of 93 clusters and first & second year activities of 19 clusters approved during 2015-16 under PKVY component of NMSA based on the release made by Government of India.
- 5. Based on the release made by Government of India, the ED, TAWDEVA has sent a consolidated proposal, received from the implementing departments i.e. Director of Agriculture and Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops. The department wise split up details are as below:-

- 6.The ED, TAWDEVA has requested the Government to sanction an amount of Rs. 336.60 lakh (Gol share of Rs. 201.96 lakh and State share of Rs. 134.64 lakh as second instalment for 200 new clusters of 2018-19 and Rs.266.966 lakh including Government of India share Rs.160.180 lakh and state share Rs.106.786 lakh for the balance activities of previous years (2015-16 to 2018-19) and current year activity relating to the development of 112 clusters for implementation of the component Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana under NMSA during 2018-2019
- 7. After careful examination, the Government accept the proposal of the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (TAWDEVA) and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.336.60 lakh (Rupees Three crore thirty six lakh and sixty thousand only)(Gol share of Rs. 201.96 lakh and State share of Rs.134.64 lakh) as second instalment for 200 new clusters of 2018-19 and Rs.266.966 lakh (Rupees Two second instalment for 200 new clusters of 2018-19 and Rs.266.966 lakh (Rupees Two

crore sixty six lakh ninety six thousand and six hundred only) (GoI share of Rs.160.18 lakh and state share 106.786 lakh) for the balance activities of previous years (2015-16 to 2018-19) including 2% administrative cost to the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (TAWDEVA), for implementation of Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY) under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) scheme on 60:40 sharing basis during 2018-19, as detailed in the Annexure I-III to this order.

- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited to the Heads of Account given in the annexures to this order.
- 9. Necessary funds have been provided in FMA/FSE 2018-19. The Director of Agriculture and the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops are permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 7 above.
- 10. The Director of Horticulture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount to Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency (TANHODA) for implementing the project.
- 11. The concerned Assistant Directors of Agriculture are permitted to draw the advance amount of Rs.750/- per cluster for conducting Lead Resource Person Trainings and Rs.36,330/- per cluster for conducting Organic fairs for the clusters approved during 2015-16 and permitted to draw the advance amount for conducting Organic fair/ melas/ Exhibition and exposure visit for lead farmers for clusters approved during 2018-19 as per revised guideline.
- 12. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned as administrative cost (Annexure-III) and disburse it to the ED, TAWDEVA for depositing into the Savings Bank account for incurring administrative expenditure at TAWDEVA.
- 13. The Implementing Departments are directed to scrupulously follow the PKVY Guidelines issued by the Government of India and follow the cost norms and pattern of assistance while implementing the projects. The implementing Departments are further directed to ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them in time.
- 14. The Implementing Departments are also directed to monitor the implementation process and progress at the State & District levels effectively and to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency and to the Government.
- 15. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (TAWDEVA) is requested to send the monthly progress report by 10th of the subsequent month and the utilization certificate in the prescribed format to the Government of India under intimation to this Government without fail.
