ORDER:

In the Government Order read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.13.33 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.6.67 lakh towards implementation of "Crop Diversification Programme", a Sub scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana-RAFTAAR 2020-2021 as follows:-

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Government of India have released a sum of Rs.4.00 lakh as 2nd instalment. By adding corresponding 40% State share of Rs.2.66 lakh, the total 2nd instalment amount worked out to Rs.6.66 lakh for implementation of Crop Diversification Programme under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana-RAFTAAR 2020-2021.

3. In the letter 3rd read above, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has requested the Government, to sanction a sum of Rs.6.66 lakh, for **"Establishment of New Vegetables Garden in Tobacco fields under Crop Diversification Programme"**, in Coimbatore, Erode, Dindigul, Nagapattinam, Tiruppur and Salem districts with a subsidy amount of Rs.20,000/Ha. In the scheme all tobacco farmers are eligible to a maximum of 2 Ha per farmer with a subsidy of 40% as follows.

4. In the letter 4th read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has recommended the above proposal of Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops hereby accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.6.66 lakh (Rupees Six Lakh and Sixty Six Thousand only) in the funding pattern of 60:40 between the Central and the State Governments for implementation of "Crop Diversification Programme", a sub scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana during 2020-21.

6. The Component details and the head of account to which the expenditure sanctioned in para.5 above shall be debited are mentioned in the annexure to this order.

7. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para.5 above to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency .

8. The Director of Horticulture & Plantation Crops is permitted to fix the Physical target based on the need and potential of the districts as per the guidelines of Government of India.

9. The Director of Horticulture & Plantation Crops is directed to follow the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana – RAFTAAR guidelines and furnish the monthly report to the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for onward transmission to Government of India.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.50024/Fin(Agri)/2020, Dated 29.12.2020.
