ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued, according financial sanction for a sum of Rs.505.00 lakh for implementation of Cashew Nut Area Expansion, a Sub scheme under National Agricultural Development Programme during the year 2018-19.

2. In the letter second read above, the Government of India has conveyed approval for Cashew nut Area Expansion for the year 2019-20 to the State of Tamil Nadu as Rs.144.00 lakh. Accordingly, in the letter 3rd read above, the Annual Action Plan for an amount of Rs.144.00 lakh has been sent to Government of India, after getting approval from the Chairman of State Level Sanctioning Committee of National Agriculture Development Programme.

3. Subsequently, in the letter 4th read above, the Government of India have released a sum of Rs.72.00 lakh as first instalment (50% Central Share) for implementation of Cashew nut Area Expansion under the sub scheme of National Agriculture Development Programme during the year 2019-20. By adding corresponding State share of Rs.48.00 lakh, total allocation is worked out to Rs.120.00 lakh.

4. In the letter 5th read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has forwarded, the proposal of Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, requesting financial sanction for Rs.1.20 crore comprising Government of India share of Rs.0.72 crore and State share of Rs.0.48 crore for the implementation of Cashew nut Area Expansion, a sub scheme of National Agriculture Development Programme during the year 2019-20 as detailed below:-

[This scheme will be implemented in all districts of Tamil Nadu and all farmers are eligible to a maximum of 4 Ha per farmer with 60% subsidy. Under this scheme, planting material and materials for INM/IPM (as per the norms of Mission for Integrated Development in Horticulture) will be supplied].

5. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has recommended the proposal to the Government for issue of orders.

6. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops and accord administrative sanction for Rs.2.40 crore and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.120.00 lakh (Rupees one crore and twenty lakh only) [Government of India Share Rs.72.00 lakh + State Share Rs.48.00 lakh] as first instalment for implementation of Cashew nut Area Expansion, a sub scheme of National Agriculture Development Programme during the year 2019-20 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Central and the State Governments.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para.(6) above shall be debited to the Heads of Account mentioned in the Annexure of this order.

8. Necessary additional funds for Rs.1.20 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-20. Pending provision of funds, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para.6 above to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency (TANHODA) for implementation of the project. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to include this expenditure while sending budget proposal to the Government in Finance (Agri) Department, without fail.

9. The projects should be implemented by following centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.
10. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is permitted to fix the physical target based on the need and potential of the districts. Necessary relaxation of quarterly funds is given to the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops for the effective implementation of the scheme in time.
11. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.
12. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the projects.
13. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to follow the RKVY-RAFTAAR operational guidelines while implementing the schemes and also follow the conditions mentioned in Para.8 of the Government of India letter fourth read above.
14. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcome through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.
15. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is directed to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
16. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.49578/Agri/2019, dated:18.10.2019, and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1791 (One thousand seven hundred ninety one).



