ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs. 40.00 lakhs for the continuance of Integrated Tribal Development Programme for distribution of inputs viz fruit plant materials, High Yielding Hybrid Vegetable seeds, Horticulture Training, Farmers Tour, distribution of Oil Engine and Plant Protection equipment and installation of drip irrigation system at subsidized cost in the Tribal areas for the upliftment of Tribal farmers in the following districts:-

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has sent proposals for the implementation of Integrated Tribal Development Programme at a total cost of Rs. 40.00 lakhs during 2010-11 in Yercaud, Arumuthumalai, Patchaimalai and Kalvarayan Hills in Salem District, Patchaimalai in Trichy District, Serapattu in Villupuram District, Kolli Hills in Namakkal District, Sitheri Hills in Dharmapuri District, Yelagiri Hills in Vellore District and Javathu Hills in Thiruvanamalai District.

3. The Government after careful consideration of the proposals of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, sanction the implementation of Integrated Tribal

Development Programme in the districts of Salem, Trichy, Villupuram, Namakkal, Dharmapuri, Vellore and Tiruvanamalai at a total cost of Rs. 40.00 lakhs (Rupees forty lakhs only) in the villages identified in the Tribal Areas for the year 2010-2011 taking into consideration the areas covered by Agriculture Engineering Department for the last two years besides the areas identified by the Horticulture Department. The programme details under the scheme is enclosed in the annexure 1 to this Government Order.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to:

"2401-00 Crop Husbandry-796-Tribal Area Sub-Plan Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan-II-State Plan-JA -Agricultural Schemes in Tribal Areas-Implemented by the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops-69-Procurement of Agricultural Inputs."
