ORDER:

In the Government Order third read above, a sum of Rs.238.15 lakhs had been sanctioned under Hill Area Development Programme for implementing various Horticulture Development schemes in the Nilgiris District during 2010-2011. In the letter fourth read above, the Project Director, Hill area Development Programme has sent proposals of Rs 206.80 lakhs for implementation of schemes in both the selected and other watersheds areas during 2041-2012 under Hill Area Development Programme and the same was forwarded to the Union Planning Commission, Government of india for approval. In the letter fifth read above, the Union Planning Commission, Government of india has approved an outlay of Rs.206.80 lakhs for Horticulture sector under Hill Area Development Programme ouring 2011-2012.

- 2. The Government, after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Project Director, Hill Area Development Programme and accord sanction for incurring an expenditure of Rs.206.80 takhs (Rupees Two hundred six takhs and eighty thousand only) for implementation of various Horticulture Development schemes during 2011-2012, under Hill Area Development Programme, as detailed in the Annexure to this order.
- 3. The expenditure sanctioned in para 2 above shall be debited to the head of abount "2551 Hill Areas 60 Other Hill Areas 101 Crop Husbandry Schemes in the

Eleventh Five Year Plan - il State Plan - KG Schemes for the Development of Plantation Crops under Hill Area Development Programme - 69 Procurement of Agricultural Inputs"

- 4. The Collector of Nilgiris is authorised to draw the amount sanctioned in para 2 above and to deposit it in the Savings Bank Account of District Rural Development Agency and to disburse the same to the implementing agencies by means of cheque in favour of contractors and suppliers etc., based on the request from the Commissioner of Horticulture and Plantation Crops subject to overall sanction of Rs.206.80 lakhs. Whenever cash is required for settlement of petty claims, the District Collector is authorized to draw and dispurse the same in cash and shall maintain detailed cash accounts in this regard and to get them reconciled on a monthly basis, as per the revised guidelines issued in the Government Order second read above.
- 5. The Government direct the Project Director, Hill Area Development Programme Udhagamandalam to credit the receipts on account of distribution of Vegetables seeds. Oil Engine, Power tillers. Mini tractors and Power sprayers on subsidy under the following receipt head of account viz. '0551 Hill Areas 60 Other Hill Areas 101 Crop Husbandry AD. Porticulture Receipt under Hill Area Development Programme' (0505) (DFC, 0551 60 101 AD 2008).
- each item of work prior to disbursement and a copy submitted to the District Collector/ Project Director, Hill Area Development Programme in advance for monitoring. Where relevant, a baseline survey, user needs and beneficiary identification along with relevant details of watershed features and use and likely (projected) impacts should form part of the project report so submitted. In cases where works are dependent on site selection with public participation, the details with photographic evidence and supporting remote sensing maps should be provided in the Project report. Finally, upon completion of the project, a completion report with photographs and factual report of use, impact, and beneficiary feedback should be sent along with financial details of utilization and balance surrendered including for works accounted under Letter of Credit method. In the case of Leneniciaries of inputs, Plant Protection Equipment or other equipment, a certificate shall also be provided that the beneficiary has not received this benefit during the previous years and is therefore, eligible for the incentive to adopt technology.
- 7. The Project Director, Hill Area Development Programme, Udhagamandalam and the Commissioner of Horbiculture and Plantation Crops, Chemistry are requested to send progress report on the Horbiculture schemes sanctioned in para 2 above by the 15th of every morith without fail and ensure that the subsidy involved in the schemes under the sector should be kept at minimum and in any case not more than that allowed in similar Centrally sponsored/State Plan schemes.
- 8. The Agricultural Production Commissioner and Secretary to Government, Agriculture Department is requested to watch the implementation of the above schemes, as envisaged in the Government Chiler first read above.
