## ORDER:-

In Government Order first read above, the Government accorded sanction for implementation of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) 9 Non-National Horticulture Mission Districts viz. Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur, Karur, Namakkal, Thiruvarur, Tuticorin, Nagapattinam, Thiruvannamalai and Virudhunagar during 2017-2018 under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) guidelines and it is reported that, the amount sanctioned during the year 2017-2018, for Rs.411.777 lakh was fully utilized and an area of 4581.21 ha was brought under cultivation of Horticulture crops.

- 2. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops in his letter second read above has sent a proposal to Government to bring more area of Horticulture Crops under Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) during 2018-2019 in 9 Non-National Horticulture Mission Districts (viz., Kancheepuram, Karur, Namakkal, Nagapattinam, Thiruvarur, Thiruvallur, Thiruvannamalai, Tuticorin, and Virudhunagar at an amount of Rs.498.244 lakh under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) Norms. Under the scheme, focus will be given to area expansion of Vegetable Crops, Fruit Crops, Spices, Flower Crops and Plantation crops. In respect of Vegetables and Flower crops, hybrid seed material and planting material will be distributed to farmers at 40% cost, upto 2 ha. In respect of Fruits, Spices and Plantation Crops, Planting material and Seed & Seedlings of Spices will be distributed to farmers at 40% cost, upto 4 ha.
- 3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.411.77 lakh (Rupees Four crore eleven lakh seventy seven thousand only) towards implementation of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) in 9 Non-NHM Districts viz. Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur, Karur, Namakkal, Thiruvarur, Tuticorin, Nagapattinam, Thiruvannamalai and Virudhunagar for the year 2018-2019 under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) guidelines.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of accounts:-
